Nottingham's Mental Health Team's parent tip of the week: Research has shown that practicing gratitude helps people be happier and less depressed. During a quiet family time (e.g. dinner, a long car ride) try having all family members answer three gratitude questions: 1) What is something you saw, smelled, tasted or heard today that made you feel happy or grateful; 2) what is something someone did for you today that made you happy or grateful; 3) what is something you did today that made you feel happy or grateful? Modeling gratitude is a great way to help your children develop a grateful attitude.

Extended Day Registration for 2021-22 School Year Opens Tue, May 25: Extended Day is planning for normal operations for the 2021-22 school year and registration began Tuesday, May 25. However, COVID-19 restrictions and precautions could affect Extended Day opening and/or capacity.

PHASE 1: May 25 - June 8

Registration opens for students who were enrolled* in the Extended Day after school session for the 2020-21 school year. Siblings of students enrolled last year, who were not in Extended Day, may also register at this time. Families registering during this period will participate in a lottery and receive a family enrollment number:

- If Extended Day is able to operate at normal, pre-pandemic capacities: all students registered during this period will be **conditionally enrolled.
- If Extended Day must operate at reduced capacity: students will be enrolled in order of their lottery-determined enrollment number until capacity at each grade level is reached. Remaining students will be placed on a wait list.
- *Extended Day was closed during the 2020-21 school year. However, registration was conducted, and students were enrolled prior to the closure.
- **Please note: If program capacity decreases at a late date due to COVID-related protocols, Extended Day may have to "unenroll" students to meet limited capacity. In this case, enrollment would be based on lottery number as described above.

Families can contact the Extended Day office to confirm if they were enrolled during the 2020-21 school year.

PHASE 2: June 9 - June 23

Registration opens for all students. Families registering during this period will participate in a lottery and be assigned a family enrollment number. Students will be enrolled, in order of the family enrollment number, if space is available. Otherwise they will be placed on the waitlist in order of enrollment number.

Families who register after June 23 will be placed at the end of the waitlist if their school has reached capacity, in the order that their registration is received.

PLEASE NOTE: To enroll in Extended Day for the upcoming year, the family account cannot have a past-due balance. For more information, please go to the **Extended Day website** or email **extended.day@apsva.us.**

CALLING NEW KNIGHTS:

Families are now able to register kindergarten students for the 2021-22 school year by using the Online Registration Process. Families unable to complete the registration process online are able to register by using the Student Registration Document Drop Off Process. Families can determine their neighborhood school by using the Boundary (Attendance Area) Locator and are encouraged to register before the end of the current school year to help schools prepare and plan for incoming kindergarten students.
